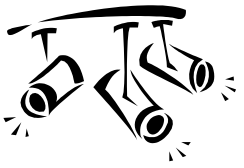
Sapphire Gentlemen's Club, world's largest strip club celebrated it's seventh anniversary....

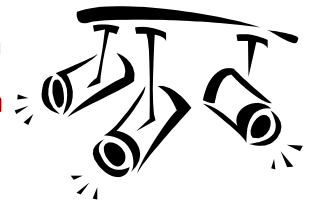

town at the same time, and bring an estimated 135,000 or more attendees.....makes for a crowded town, with higher hotel rates, etc.....not the best time to come... Consumer Electronics Show (CES) brings all the nerds, geeks, and techno guys to town, and the Adult Entertainment Expo (AEE) brings all the porno stars, and their entourages....

Last month we experienced the big opening of MGM-Mirage's CityCenter, which I've heard described as the new "CityCenter, the new vertical city on the Strip"

.... Wow are those building fantastic...a site to behold...now we just need to fill the rooms up....that would be great for the economy....rumors were hinting at "big" discounts on the those condo rooms that are for sale....CityCenter is really MGM Mirage's great investment for "future profitability and corporate longevity".....\$9 billion dollar, 67 acre city-within-a-city of hotels, condominiums, gaming halls and shopping malls co-owned by Dubai World and MGM Mirage....was almost bankrupt earlier this year (such

bad news made MGM Mirage stock drop down to around \$2 per share, currently around \$10)....

CITYCENTER'S THE ARIA: only hotel to have gambling of the six inside CityCenter opened on Dec. 16th....

CITYCENTER'S MANDARIN ORIENTAL: opened Dec. 12th....

CITYCENTER'S VDARA: first hotel to open in CityCenter....."luxury boutique hotel - all-suite Vdara Hotel & Spa".....non-smoking, non-gaming 57 story tower contains 1,500 suites and billed as an ultra modern, eco-friendly facility...Vdara is physically connected to Bellagio and directly adjacent to ARIA and has achieved LEED®† Gold certification by the U.S. Green Building Council....new building houses Silk Road, a contemporary Mediterranean restaurant, and the 18,000-sq-ft, two-level wellness spa, Vdara Health & Beauty, featuring the Veuve Clicquot Champagne Bar.....first Las Vegas spa in the Green Spa Network, and offers a selection of signature treatments focusing on holistic health....

CITYCENTER: Chihuly at CityCenter debuted last month (remember he's the artist responsible for the terrific glass structure that hangs over the Bellagio's registration area in their lobby) within the Gallery, located within new Crystals shopping experience.....spanning some 4,350 sq-ft, of course setup features a "diverse representation of world-renowned artist Dale Chihuly's sculptures, drawings, editions and prints."...Gallery is open daily from 10am to midnight...notes: "recognized for his masterful use of color, fluid forms and large-scale glass installations, Chihuly's City-Center exhibition highlights a number of his important works including Chihuly's new Silvered Venetian series, marking the artist's first application of silver as a base color." ....

CAESARS PALACE: Dec. 1, Cher marked 100th performance of her "ultra-glamorous show at The Colosseum at Caesars Palace where she has been headlining since May 2008".....

IMPERIAL PALACE: added a new restaurant, and it's a long time local's favorite...that's right, the Hash House a Go Go can now be found at Imperial Palace...original joint is still at Sahara avenue location....and they have continued their service with huge portions, same menu and size of the courses stay the same, prices have not yet gone up for the LV Strip crowd....one of our favs is fried chicken and waffles every Friday -- at \$12.95 a discount to regular \$18.95....

M RESORT: a recent Forbes Travel Guide Four Star Award Winner, displayed nation's tallest Christmas Tree, a 109-foot White Fir last month...

MGM GRAND: "The "King of Country" and 17-time Country Music Association "Entertainer of the Year" nominee George Strait will kick off his 2010 arena tour with special guest star - Reba McEntire.....two superstars are scheduled to perform together on the MGM Grand Garden Arena stage Saturday, Feb. 6 at 8pm....

THE MIRAGE: The Mirage has commemorated 20 years on The Strip....The Mirage

opened its doors November 22, 1989....."almost 600 employees have been with the property since it's opening in 1989, including current Vice President, Franz Kallao, who started his career checking in guests on opening day".....

ORLEANS: comedian Don Rickles, "who has starred in Las Vegas showrooms longer than any other performer in the history of the gambling mecca, has signed for a third consecutive year of performances with The Orleans"..... new contract marks "Mr. Warmth's" 51st consecutive year performing in Las Vegas.....first scheduled engagement will be Feb. 20 and 21....tickets start from \$74.95, call 702-365-7075....

PALMS: Grammy-award winner Ne-Yo is set to perform at The Pearl Concert Theater inside the Palms Casino Resort at 9 p.m. on Friday, Jan. 1, 2010.....tickets are \$85 and \$100, call 800-745-3000....

PLANET HOLLYWOOD: This is kind of interesting...it appears that after disappearing every night, the magician Steve Wyrick (been at Planet Hollywood since 2007, after all it was Steve Wyrick's \$35 million showroom located in the Miracle Mile Shops at Planet Hollywood) has actually "disappeared for real" from the Vegas scene....as his magic show has been cancelled...seems like the performer failed to appear last month...and from what we hear the show is no longer there...no rumors yet about his return...

PLANET HOLLYWOOD: thru Jan 3rd look for internationally acclaimed Fercos Brothers, Tony and Ferdinand, performing in "Untamed Illusions" at the Theatre for the Performing Arts at Planet Hollywood....90-minute magical spectacle will feature illusions, rare and exotic animals, dancers, world-record juggling acts, specialty acts and sets ranging from a futuristic world landscape to the wild jungles in South America...feline performers include Victoria (a Bengal tiger), Dora (a white Siberian tiger), Sinbad (a lion) and Sarina (a black leopard)....

Rio's Masquerade Village: terrific BBQ joint, The Rub Restaurant has closed, another victim of the bad economy....

RIVERA: Jay White, performing his Neil Diamond tribute show in the Le Bistro Theater at the Riviera for about eight years has closed his show in order to concentrate on a theatrical musical based on Diamond's music....before Riviera gig, White spent almost 10 years in "Legends in Concert."

SILVERTON: has extended their buy 1, get 1 free offer at restaurants indefinitely, at least for the foreseeable future....hope this remains true for 2010....anyway between 4pm and 10pm every day you can visit their 24-hour Sundance Grill, Mermaid Restaurant & Lounge, Mi Casa Grill, or Twin Creeks Steakhouse and receive one free entree with the purchase of an equal or lower-priced entree....this also includes their "high quality" Seasons Buffet, (now only open for dinner on weeknights and brunch and dinner on weekends)....if you happen to be by yourself, you may dine alone and receive 50 percent off your entree (or buffet)...which should be around \$7.50...pretty good bargain here in Las Vegas....and of course, you have to be a member of their Discovery Club (which is free to join) to participate in the promotion and there is no limit to how many times you want to take part in it...

WYNN LAS VEGAS: water-themed show, "Le Rêve," celebrated its 2,000th performance end of November last year...32-cast member show opened concurrently with Wynn Las Vegas on April 28, 2005....more than 250 cast and crew work on "Le Rêve" each day...counting all 2,000 performances, they have used 1,200,000 towels, more than 12,800 pairs of red tango shoes have been repaired, and some 104,000 loads of laundry have been done....wow!!

WYNN'S ENCORE: Steve Wynn signed Garth Brooks (started Dec. 11th) to a long-term contract at the Encore Theater, selling out his entire first 15 weeks in record time.... now we hear rumors that Beyonce may join Brooks in a similar long-term residency at Wynn Las Vegas....wouldn't that be something...you might remember that last summer...Beyonce was performing and filming her new concert CD at Encore, with some show and room packages available....so maybe that's when the talks started...hmmmm....of course, it doesn't hurt that those sales were very successful...so she may be appearing during Brooks' off-nights....

BINION'S (downtown): hotel-casino that launched the World Series of Poker closed down (as of Dec. 14th) its 365-room hotel tower, keno and coffee shop and keeping open the casino including the poker room and steakhouse on the 24th floor....closure means about 100 workers laid off....Binion's opened in 1951 and was purchased last year by TLC Enterprises, owners of Four Queens....haven't heard about the Four Queens' 690 rooms...was by Binion's and it was very quiet...casino pretty empty...no one playing poker...

GOLDEN NUGGET (downtown): located across the street from Binion's, opened a \$150 million 500-room tower last month....1st new hotel rooms in downtown Las Vegas in about 20 years....downtown Las Vegas "luxury" accommodations has jumped up considerably with opening of the Rush Tower at the Golden Nugget....brightly colored interior features Las Vegas' only Chart House restaurant including a 75,000-gallon tropical aquarium....also their new restaurant, Red, serves the best in sushi, steaks and seafood....there's also The Grand, an 11,000 sq-ft event center....available for special events, conventions and meeting rooms....not to mention that The Rush Tower also adds almost 500 oversize rooms and suites to give the Golden Nugget a total of 2,300 guest rooms....

THE PLAZA (downtown): bingo promotion - \$125,000 Super Bingo Feb. 20-21, 2010....

If you're into tiki rooms...you got to check out: Frankie's Tiki Room, "the only authentic tiki bar in Las Vegas"...they celebrated its first anniversary last month...Frankie's is located at 1712 W. Charleston Blvd. and open 24 hours every day...

Sammy Hagar opened *Cabo Wabo Cantina*, on the Las Vegas Strip....two-level, 15,000-sq-ft Cantina has a prime location with an outdoor patio at the Miracle Mile Shops at Planet Hollywood....

Casino drinking rules...true stuff from one who has had hands on experience...you might find some of this amusing...but please pay attention if you fit the category...of a casino tippler. Sit at end of bar nearest to a Keno Lounge...once you have had a few...slip off your stool and slide into the middle of the back row of the Keno Lounge for a little nap...then you will awake refreshed and ready to attack the spirits again....
